

# Churchmen call for impartial <sup>17/7/73</sup> massacre inquiry

A Roman Catholic body, the steering committee of the Commission for International Justice and Peace, of the English and Welsh bishops' conference, last night called for an immediate, impartial inquiry into reports of oppression and violence in Mozambique.

The committee said it had noted the apparent reference to events in Mozambique by the Pope, who was speaking out "on behalf of the oppressed both in Africa and elsewhere in the world".
