Rebels in Mozambique Reportedly Attack Town

Rebels fighting the Marxist government of Mozambique attacked the town of Inhaminga in that southern African country, killing two people, looting shops and demolishing a train, reports from Mozambique said today.

Two unidentified French nationals traveling on the train were kidnapped by the guerrillas and released after pro-Government forces paid a ransom, the Portuguese news agency reported.
