

BURNING, KILLING, Africa(AFP), Feb. 26, '82

Lisbon, February 25 - A spokesman for the anti-Government Mozambican National Resistance Movement (MNRM) today said its forces burned public buildings and killed seven soldiers in the southern town of Funhaloro on Monday. A 60-strong force occupied the cattle and forestry town for 24 hours, during which they burned all its public buildings except for schools and a health centre, the spokesman said. The MNRM forces also burned several acres of forest, whose wood is notably used for railway line sleepers, he added.
