MNR kills two people

Salisbury, Friday.

TWO men were killed in a grenade attack in eastern Zimbabwe recently, and police have blamed Mozambican rebels.

It was believed to be the first time that the "Mozambique National Resistance (RNM), sponsored by South Africa, had attacked a target inside this country, security sources said.

A police spokesman said the unidentified men were killed and a youth wounded at 3 a.m. on Monday as they slept in a house in the Ngorima District in the bush south of Melsetter.

"It is believed this was the work of the Mozambique Resistance Movement who were allegedly looking for a deserter believed to be staying in that house"
