

Kidnapped Briton freed by bandits

British zoologist John Burlinson, kidnapped by Mozambique anti-government bandits last December, was released unharmed yesterday over the border with Zimbabwe, a spokesman for the so-called Mozambique National Resistance said in Lisbon.

Mr. Burlinson was kidnapped on December 17 during an attack on the Gorongosa Wildlife Park in central Mozambique where he was director of the park school.

In Maputo, it was announced that Mozambique has sent a high-level delegation, including the country's top negotiator with the Soviet Union and the armed forces chief of staff, on a visit to Moscow. MS 25/5/82
