Repairs to sabotaged power lines serving Beira (Text) Electricity crews are working to restore normal electricity supply to the town of Beira following a sabotage attack by anti-Mozambique terrorists last Wednesday [14th July]. The terrorists sabotaged the city's power lines from the (?Mavusi) power station, 200 km west of Belra near the Zimbabwa border. An alternative electricity system was put into operation immediately to ensure power supply to the hospital, the airport, communications and other essential services,

Temporary restrictions have been placed on non-essential electricity consumption, and

the public were called on to exercise austerity until the (?Mavusi) line is repaired.
