

Defector pilot quits SADF

THE Frelimo defector, Lieutenant Adriano Bomba, who flew to South Africa in a MIG jet fighter aircraft, has left the employ of the South African Defence Force, a spokes-

man for the SADF said yesterday.

He was commenting on reports that Lt Bomba is at present working for the resistance movement in Mozambique — the Resistencia Nacional

of Mozambique (MNR).

The spokesman said that the SADF had no knowledge of Lt Bomba's present whereabouts, but confirmed that he had left the SADF

in April for personal reasons.

He said that Lt Bomba, who had been granted permanent residence in South Africa, had been employed in a civilian capacity as he said he had no further interest in flying. He said that he had virtually been forced by Frelimo to take up flying.

While working for the SADF he was employed in the translation of Russian/Portuguese propaganda

A spokesman for the Department of Internal Affairs yesterday declined to confirm or deny that Lt Bomba had been issued with a passport and/or other travelling documents since being granted permanent South African residence.
