

**Reported detention of another Portuguese national in Mozambique (Text)** A Portuguese national, Rui Manuel Amorim Janeiro, has been arrested in the Mozambican city of Beira for suspected involvement in anti-government activities, the Portuguese news agency, ANOP learned today from diplomatic sources in Maputo. The arrest of Rui Janeiro, a technician working for the company that runs the [Beira-Mutare] pipeline, took place three days ago and brought to 10 the number of Portuguese detained in Mozambique on similar grounds since last December. Nunes Berata, a senior official at the Portuguese Embassy in Maputo, today returned from the city of Beira after having contacts with the local authorities on the situation of the Portuguese detainees.
