MNR radio warns foreigners of Red August campaign In a programme on the movement's Red August offensive against the "communist forces", the "Voice of the Mozambique National Resistance" warned all non-communist countries and organizations with citizens working in Mozambique that the MNR would not accept responsibility for the deaths of or injuries to foreign personnel during the offensive. It said that if the movement was not warned about the presence of foreign personnel, "their blood will certainly be shed" with that of the communists.
