
MNR "threat" to S African and Portuguese troops (Text of Lisbon radio report) The Mozambican National Resistance [movement: MNR or Renamo] threatened yesterday that any Portuguese and South African military personnel collaborating with the Frelimo regime in its anti-guerrilla struggle would be executed by firing squad if captured. Renamo said that 1,000 South African regular troops were to be deployed in Mozambique on a volunteer basis to protect the power lines from the Cahora Bassa hydro-electric plant and rail and road links.
