
Report on MNR captives (Text of Capital Radio, Umtata, report) Mozambique's MNR rebels say they will negotiate directly with the governments representing the two men they took captive one week ago. The two Durban-based engineers, Malcolm Blakely of Britain, and John O'Connell of Northern Ireland [as heard] were captured in an MNR attack on a British-owned sugar refinery in northern Mozambique.
