

Testimony of captured MNR "bandit" and capture of seven others (Text) An armed bandit called Jorge Valoi has pointed out that he was trained in South Africa this year and subsequently infiltrated into Mozambique. Valoi, aged 23, was speaking to journalists in Maputo today. He said that in May this year, he illegally entered South African territory where the authorities arrested him. He said he was jailed for a few days and then handed to the armed bandits. Jorge Valoi said that he received a month's training in the Phalaborwa base after which he was infiltrated into the south of Mozambique where, according to his statement, he killed four people and was involved in the destruction of nine village communes. Valoi was captured by the Mozambique armed forces in Manhica last October. (Maputo in Portuguese 1700 gmt 4 Nov 85)
