

## 'MNR using Malawi 5.12.45 as refuge'

TWO district administrators in the north-western province of Tete say that MNR bandits are using Malawi as a base.

The administrator of the Angonia district told Radio Mozambique that unidentified planes from Malawi had violated Mozambican airspace. He referred to an incident in early July when two helicopters flew over Tsangano in Angonia and dropped supplies to an MNR camp.

He said that from January to November 43 bandits had been killed in Angonia.

The radio quoted the governor of Macanga district, which also borders Malawi, as saying that MNR bandits frequently fled over the border into Malawi when they were confronted by Mozambican troops.

He added that people freed from MNR control in Macanga had also testified to the use of Malawi as a base. —
