

# Newsman among three Nampula mine victims

MAPUTO.

A JOURNALIST with the mass communications office in the Mozambican Ministry of Information was one of the three people killed recently in the northern province of Nampula when their car hit a mine placed by bandits of the South African-backed Mozambican National Resistance.

He was identified as Cde Fernando Juma.

Cde Juma and his companions were travelling in a convoy, but theirs was the only vehicle to hit a mine.

In Maputo two of those injured in Monday's car bomb attack in the central Maputo district of Alto Mae are still in hospital, but medical sources said that they were off the danger list. — Ziana-AIM.
