

Mozambican military claims and call for vigilance (ME/8316/B/10: excerpts) The Mozambican armed forces killed 87 of South Africa's MNR terrorists in Maputo province in southern Mozambique in the first two weeks of this month. In a communique issued yesterday, the provincial military command says some of the casualties were inflicted when the army attacked and destroyed four terrorist camps in Magude and Manhica districts of Maputo province. . . The communique says the terrorists have now broken up into small groups in the area, but the communique warned that there are still terrorists active in the area and says they are dangerous. . .
