Mozambicans in South Africa forcibly recruited by "armed bandits" (Excerpt) The Mozambican side of the Mozambican-South African security commission has informed the South African side that there was evidence that camps for displaced Mozambicans situated along the border inside South Africa were being transformed into centres of forced recruiting into the armed bandit ranks, AIM [Mozambique news agency] reported. AIM also said that a number of Mozambicans who have been fleeing to South Africa from armed bandits are forced to accept meagre salaries on farms very much below those stipulated by South African law.

Meanwhile, South African Manpower Minister Du Plessis, said yesterday that Mozambican immigrants were denying South Africans a series of important jobs, thus seriously increasing the problem of unemployment in some areas of South Africa. . . (Maputo home service in Portuguese 1030 gmt 2 Aug 86)
