

Maputo airspace violated

MAPUTO. — Mozambique's People's National Security Service said here yesterday that the country's airspace has been violated over the last few days by aircraft landing men and war materials in the central province of Manica.

SNASP said that the aircraft were identical to South African aircraft that supplied the headquarters of the MNR bandits in Gorongosa district with arms before it was captured in August last year by Mozambican and Zimbabwean troops. — Ziana-ADM.
