

# Sithole teams up with MNR bandits

THE Zimbabwe African National Union led by the Rev. Ndabaningi Sithole has signed a co-operation agreement with Mozambique National Resistance bandits and is preparing to take up arms against the Government.

According to the Sunday Times of South Africa, the pact was signed between Rev Sithole's Zanu and MNR bandit officials in Washington two weeks ago. But the report did not specify who signed for Zanu.

MNR bandit sources who spoke to the newspaper said: "Zanu has received a large grant from an American organisation and there are a lot of supporters ready to take up arms and go into action."

The bandit sources added that: "The intention is to link Zanu, MNR and Unita to oust marxist regimes."

Rev Sithole is in exile but the publicity secretary of his party Mr Mabhaudhi Zengeni and Zanu MP Goodson Sithole last week said they wanted to be included in unity discussions with the ruling Zanu (PF).
