

On 20 August the Washington Times Published an article in which it was asked who spoke for Renamo. On 1st September ARTUR FONSECA replied saying that he was Renamo's Secretary for external Relations. On 8 September VILANCULOS wrote to the Washington Times saying that he was the one who had credentials from people like General JOHN SINGLAUB, FRANZ JOSEPH STRAUSS of Bavaria, MAHLUZA and KEMBO as well as from Renamo's legal representative in the U.S., BOAVENTURA LEMANE. He added that FONSECA had attacked him in articles published in the Portuguese Magazine Africa Confidential in December 1985.

There is a group called FREE THE EAGLE, which supports professor SERAPIAO and another called conservative action Foundation, which supports VILANCULOS. The heritage Foundation says it will remain neutral until the dust settles.

FONSECA apparently lives in west Germany. SERAPIAO was appointed U.S. representative by EVO FERNANDES on 21 May, and registered as a Foreign agent at the Department of Justice on 8 August.
