Mozambican rebels reportedly ambush train (Text) It is reported that Mozambican rebels have derailed a freight train destined for Zimbabwe. A Portuguese news agency, quoting Western diplomatic sources, says the train was ambushed in the vital Beira corridor yesterday. The report gives no further details and there has been no immediate word of casualties or damage. The alleged attack came just a day after Mozambique warned the government of Malawi that it would close the border if it did not stop supporting the MNR rebels.
