Landmine explosion damages Maputo-S Africa railway line A landmine exploded on 15th October on the Maputo-South Africa railway line, damaging 800 metres of track and causing the derailment of seven wagons and a goods locomotive travelling from Maputo to Ressano Garcia on the South African border, Maputo radio reported. The line is being repaired and is expected to reopen on the 17th. The radio recalled that the last act of sabotage on the Maputo-Ressano Garcia line had occurred on 24th September.
