Man injured in land mine blast near Mozambican border (Text) The police division of public relations in Pretoria has confirmed that a 52-year-old black man was injured in the

Imbuzini [phonetic] tribal area in KaNgwane, when he detonated a land mine. It is the same area where six national servicemen were injured last week, when their army vehicle detonated a land mine. The man, an employee of the Department of Veterinary Services at Komatipoort, was inspecting a fence along the Mozambican border when he trod on the land mine. He suffered shrapnel wounds and is being treated in the Shongwe hospital in KaNgwane. (Johannesburg home service in English 1.500 gmt 17 Oct 86)
