

Maputo's Rebels To Fight Harare

LISBON — Rebels of the rightist Mozambican National Resistance said Tuesday that they would strike against military and economic targets inside Zimbabwe.

The announcement was made in a statement by Afonso Dhlakama, the leader of the resistance, to news agencies.

Mr. Dhlakama said the declaration was to retaliate for a vow by Prime Minister Robert Mugabe on Sunday that Zimbabwe would fight to the last man to prevent the Mozambican resistance from taking power in Mozambique.
