MNR kills seven in Nyamapanda

SEVEN members of one family were attacked and killed by a gang of Mczambique National Resistance bandits on Thursday night at Joromani village, Nyamapanda in Mudzi, a police spokesman said yesterday.

The bandits were armed with AK rifles and axes. Victims were backed to death with axes and three of the bodies were later burnt.

The names of the victims, who are all of the Mwanawambane family are: Jim Phenias (husband) (49), Agnes Jumbe (wife) (45), Pondeke (son) (5), Kamutsvairo (daughter) (4), Jannet (daughter) (3), Machiveyi (daughter) (3) and Katandika (daughter) (1).

Security forces follow-up operations are in progress.
