MNR bandits massacre

MAPUTO — Bandits of the MNR massacred 14 people in an attack on a village in the central Mazambican province of Schala on Sunday, according to a report in the daily paper Diario de Mocambique, published in the port city of Belra.

The MNR struck in the early hours of the mosning at the village of Mucodun, about 15 km from the town of Gorongosa. The motive for the raid, says the paper, was to steal foud.

Of the 14 dead some were shot, others were stabbed to death with beyonets. A further 44 were injured. Those in a serious condition were taken to the spentral hospital in Belra.
