Mozambique: Australian missionary jailed for "security offences" Ian Grey, accused of "security offences" in Mozambique, was sentenced on 23rd March to 24 years in jail; the court however subsequently reduced the sentence to ten-and-a-half years "after considering some extenuating circumstances and special Mozambican government laws", Maputo radio reported that day. His defence lawyer said his client "would tell the world that he had been used by people coming from Bible colleges in the US-A... The lawyer said Ian Grey was a victim of lies and propaganda."
