Rebels Reportedly Kill 28, Including Briton AU0106130888 Paris AFP in English 1250 GMT 1 Jun 88

[Text] Lisbon, June 1 (AFP) — Rebels in Mozambique killed 28 soldiers, including two Cubans and a British military instructor, in an attack on a camp at Magude last Sunday, the guerilla movement Renamo said Wednesday.

Magude is 120 kilometres (74 miles) from the capital Maputo. Renamo (Mozambique National Resistance) said there was a heavy weapons and motorized brigade training school there run by military staff from Britain and Zimbabwe.

Two local battalions and one from Zimbabwe were defending it. The other dead in Sunday's fighting were 16 Mozambican and nine Zimbabwean troops, RENAMO said.
