

Mozambique armed forces claim six MNR bases destroyed (Text) In operations carried out in Maputo province over the past 15 days, Mozambique armed forces has destroyed six armed bandit bases. Speaking to the 'Noticias' newspaper, the provincial military commander, Col Jorge Hussene, said that the bases were destroyed in Cachane, Malengane, Macandane, Marracuene, and Matongomane. The source added that 24 armed bandits and large quantities of military equipment were captured during the operations. Hundreds of citizens, who had been abducted by the gangsters, were freed. Meanwhile, in Maputo province, 13 armed bandits have surrendered. They have been reintegrated into society within the context of the amnesty law.
