**Mozambique: 25 "bandits" killed in Maputo province** (*Excerpts*) Our forces killed 25 armed bandits in Namaacha, in Maputo province, on the night of 24th July. The criminals were killed at approximately 2300 as they carried out an attack against the town. The border guard troops counter-attacked immediately and repulsed the enemy's murderous attack at 0200 in the morning. In the process, our forces killed 25 armed bandits. . . One of the dead criminals was wearing South African army epaulettes. Meanwhile, senior military sources have disclosed that the bandits, who were divided into six groups, murdered four civilians, burned five vehicles, and stole food and drink from a number of commercial establishments in Namaacha. . .
