(Text) Mozambique Armed Forces units killed 28 armed bandits in operations between August and September 1988. Two armed bandit camps were destroyed in Inhassune and Malene, Manjacaze district, Gaza province. More than 80 citizens forced to live with the bandits were freed, and 250 head head of cattle were recovered. Reports from Gaza province say Chimbonzane, Marangue, Vamangue, Matchinane, Mbanze and Mussengue villages, which had been destroyed by the armed bandits, are being reconstructed.
