

Mozambique: 1,700 flee “bandit captivity” in Morrumbala district

Maputo home service in Portuguese 1030 gmt 3 Oct 88:

More than 1,700 people who fled bandit captivity turned themselves in to the authorities in Zambezia province's Morrumbala district last week. The co-ordinator of the Morrumbala District Emergency Commission told Radio Mozambique that dozens of people turn themselves in to the authorities daily. He also disclosed that these people turn up half-naked and suffering from serious illnesses.
