

Mozambique reports two Renamo members killed in Beira corridor

Maputo in English for abroad 1100 gmt 19 Oct 88:

The Mozambican armed forces killed two terrorists of South Africa's MNR gang on Sunday [16th October] in the Inchope district of the Central province of Manica. The bandits were part of a group that launched an abortive attack on the small town of Inchope, which lies on the Beira corridor, linking Zimbabwe to the port of Beira.

It is also reported that, last week, three more bandits surrendered to the authorities at the town of Cuamba, in the northern province of Niassa. The three are benefiting from the amnesty for those who surrender to the authorities. They have been provided with food and clothing and are now integrated into active productivity.
