

Mozambique: government forces kill 34 “armed bandits” in two months

Maputo home service in Portuguese 1030 gmt 4 Oct 88:

In operations carried out in Jangamo and Inharrime districts of Inhambane province in the past two months, FPLM [forces] killed 34 armed bandits. Our Inhambane correspondent reports that our forces captured eight AKM weapons and assorted war materiel during the operations. The source added that 72 people who had been forced to live with the gangsters were freed. Other reports from Inhambane say that one armed bandit surrendered with his weapon to our authorities in Inhassure, Panda district, within the framework of the amnesty law.
