

Mozambique - MNR claims to have taken an army barracks (Text) The MNR has claimed it has taken the army barracks at Inhaminga. An MNR spokesman said today [26th October] in Lisbon that the rebel forces had occupied the army barracks in the village of Inhaminga 170 km from Beira, capital of the Sofala province. During the attack last Thursday, 27 soldiers were killed, 17 taken prisoner and large quantities of armaments and medical supplies seized.
