

Two Mozambicans killed

LISBON. — Two people were killed and about 30 injured when a mine planted by suspected MNR bandits exploded under a train near the Mozambican capital Maputo, the Portuguese news agency Lusa reported yesterday. Railway officials said the train was taking Mozambican migrant workers, mainly employed in mines in neighbouring South Africa, home for Christmas holidays, Lusa said. — Ziana-Reuter, C
