Mozambican Red Cross official and three ICRC workers abducted Three ICRC workers and an official of the Mozambican Red Cross were abducted during an attack on Bemba, Nampula province, on 16th March, Maputo radio reported on the 21st. The radio added that an official of the ICRC information department had confirmed that the four were in the hands of the "armed bandits".
