Mozambique: rebel attack kills missionaries and soldiers (Text) Mozambican rebels have attacked an island in the eastern part of the country, killing two Italian missionaries and eight soldiers. Several civilians are also feared dead. A spokesman for the Roman Catholic Capuchin order said the rebels attacked a local governor's house, killing eight soldiers before turning their attention to the nearby theological college.
