

Zimbabwe ^H named as 13/4/89 MNR victim

AN annual report by the United States State Department lists Zimbabwe as the seventh country out of 11 countries in which 75 percent of the world's incidents of terrorism occurred last year.

The report says that almost all the international incidents were raids into Zimbabwe by MNR bandits from Mozambique. Random killings rose to at least 55 from 37 in the previous year.

Topping the list was Zionist Israel, which remained the primary target of Palestinian guerillas, although the report does not give the total number of attacks as it does for other countries.

Among the attacks mentioned in the report are a bus hijacking in which three Israelis were killed and a grenade attack against a pedestrian mall in Haifa, in which 25 people were injured. — Ziana-AP.
