The bandits however, managed to axe the girl's right hand buttock and further injured another male named only as DALIYO aged 26 years.

PETAUKE

Petauke on 02 December, 1989 unknown number of lightly armed RENAMO bandits attacked Chipekwe village in Chief MWANJAMANTHU area of Petauke District. During the attack, they axed to death Muyenga PHIRI aged 14 years, Peter PHIRI aged 06 years Mrs Leah PHIRI aged 38 years and Mrs Esnart PHIRI aged 50 years. They also injured Esnart BANDA aged 50 years and Mrs Matildeh PHIRI whose age was not established.

03	08/17/89	CHADIZA	At about 2100 hours MNR rebels simultaneously attacked Mr Lingililani BANDA's Farm and Chapoka Village in Welele area of Chadiza District. During the raid, the rebels killed six (06) unnamed Zambians and rustled thirty-five (35) herds of cattle. Own troops subsequently pursued the invaders and managed to recover only twenty-eight (28) herds of cattle.
04	10/12/89	PETAUKE	At about 2300 hours MNR rebels raided MBILIVAKONI village in Chief Ndake's area in Petauke District, injuring one woman. However, one rebel got killed by vigilantes.
05	17/12/89	PETAUKE	RENAMO bandits raided Keingeni village in Chief MIANJAWANTHU's area, killing Mrs KAYENGANI and stole property.

06	13/01/90	KATETE	<p>At about 2245 hours 05 MNR rebels accompanied by unknown number of couriers armed with rifles attacked Mr Sailawa PHIRI's Farm house at Mtemba village in Chief Kawaza's area. Shot dead were Dorica PHIRI the mother to Mr Sailawa PHIRI and Koji PHIRI the son of Mr Sailawa PHIRI. Mrs Tezia PHIRI wife of Sailawa PHIRI was reported missing. Injured were Mr Sailawa PHIRI, Tilifina NKHOMA and Anavane PHIRI. A Datsun van registration number ARA 1729 white in colour for Mr Sailawa was partially burnt.</p>
