

RENAMO's lonely delegation in Lisbon ION 13/1/90

According to information obtained by the *Indian Ocean Newsletter*, the South African "services" have recently put an end to the support they gave to the RENAMO delegation in Lisbon. The fax and coding/decoding system used by the organisation in their communications has been completely dismantled. Portuguese sources have acknowledged that "*for the time being, the visible aspects of Pretoria's support to the guerilla force no longer exist.*"

Furthermore, the head of external relations of RENAMO, Brigadier **Raul Domingos**, was staying in Carcavelos, on the outskirts of Lisbon at the end of last year at the invitation of the SIM, formerly known as *DINFO* - the Portuguese military information services. While the trip was organised with the approval of the Portuguese government which had, itself, informed Maputo, the head of the RENAMO contingent in Lisbon was not informed of his visit.
