**Mozambican minister accuses "armed bandits" of attacking relief workers**     *(Text)* Co-operation Minister Jacinto Veloso has accused armed bandits of deliberately attacking vehicles and workers carrying emergency aid to needy people in the country's rural areas. He was speaking at the national meeting on the emergency programme in Mozambique, taking place in Maputo. The minister said that last year at least 30 trucks with foodstuffs or seeds were burned by armed bandits. The meeting is being attended by representatives of the international community and Mozambican institutions involved in the assistance programme for war and natural disaster victims in the country. *(Radio Mozambique, Maputo, in Portuguese 0800 gmt 1 Feb 90)*
