

# 5 BANDIT VICTIMS BURIED

**FIVE** people who were brutally murdered by a gang of between 20 to 25 MNR bandits at Muchambachaza Village in Mutasa District were buried last Friday.

The five were Cde Esitere Changwena (50), Beauty Mujangu (12), Dadirai Mujangu (nine), Kudakwashe Mujangu (six), and five-year-old Doca Chaoneka. Four other villagers were injured when the bandits attacked them at night.

## UNDRESS

A police spokesman in Mutare said follow up operations by security forces are in progress.

He said before the bandits committed the atrocities, they ordered their victims to undress, looted three homes of property valued at \$1 500 and ordered some locals to carry the loot across the border into Mozambique.

Some villagers said the bandits looked very hungry as they were seen eating raw maize, raw bananas and uncooked chickens.

## FUNERAL

The funeral was attended by Natural Resources and Tourism Minister, Cde Victoria Chitepo, a Deputy Minister of Political Affairs, Cde Oppah Muchinguri, united Zanu (PF) Manicaland provincial chairman, Cde Zororo Duri and other senior party and Government officials.
