Mozambique train crash kills 17; S African spokesman alleges sabotage A spokesman for South African Railways said in Johannesburg on 17th April that 17 people had been killed and many others injured when a train travelling from the South African border post of Komatipoort in eastern Transvaal to the Mozambican capital was derailed after an explosion 57 km from Maputo. A 200-metre stretch of the railway line was damaged in the explosion, which derailed 16 carriages, used mainly to transport coal. According to the spokesman, the saboteurs had apparently planted antipersonnel mines along the line. [3]
