MOZAMBIQUE: Portuguese intelligence's new RENAMO man

The Portuguese Military Intelligence Service, SIM, invited RENAMO's leader, Afonso Dhlakama to send a new envoy to Lisbon to replace the former representative of the rebel organisation in Portugal, Joao Almirante, whose visa renewal application was refused two months ago (ION N°431). Mr Dhlakama's new representative, José Augusto, Director of the RENAMO Presidency, is housed on the SIM's premises in Carcavelos, near Lisbon. He travels between the SIM building, Nairobi and the RENAMO base in Gorongosa, in Mozambique.

The Portuguese SIM is also quite interested in the activities of some Catholic orders, notably, the Franciscans, who have played a non-negligible role in organising the recent direct negotiations between the FRELIMO and the RENAMO in Rome (ION N°439).

<u>I.O.N.</u>- The arrival of José Augusto seems to signify the end, at least temporarily, of the deterioration in relations between Portugal and the RENAMO leader which followed the SIM's invitation to Mr Dhlakama to go to Lisbon, a gesture which was frowned upon by the Serviços de Informação e Segurança (SIS) (ION N°426).
