

Mozambique: MNR reportedly kill four in attack on train (Text) A group of MNR armed bandits murdered four people and wounded another three in an attack on a joint passenger and cargo train on the Ressano Garcia railroad on 8th August. The attack was at kilometre 72 [sentence as heard]. A source from the CFM-South [Mozambique Railways] enterprise has disclosed that six passenger coaches and two wagons were burned but the train had not been derailed. Most of the passengers aboard the train were miners. The Ressano Garcia railroad is expected to reopen to traffic today. (*Radio Mozambique, Maputo, in Portuguese 0900 gmt 9 Aug 90*)
