

20 MNR bandits killed ^{30/11}/₄₀

MOZAMBIQUE troops killed 20 MNR bandits last Thursday, when the bandits attempted to raid an area in Mocuba district, central Zambezia Province.

The army also beat back an attack against the small town of Molavele, Ile district, in the same province. Twenty-one bandits were killed.

The Maputo daily paper Noticias said that three unidentified armed men were shot dead during a raid against a Frelimo party school at Inhazua, on the outskirts of the central port city of Beira.

During the clash, one student was killed and several others were wounded. The raiders, described as a "large group" wearing military uniform, set fire to the dormitories and stole most of the goods in the building. — Ziana-Pana.
