HARARE. — Zimbabwean troops stationed in Mozambique have been completely withdrawn from the country, the Ziana news agency reports.

Their withdrawn

was a week ahead of the January 5 deadline for them to be out of Mozambique.

Captain Aiphios Makotore of the Zimbabwe National Army said the majority of the troops had now been deployed in the Beira Corridor and those who were in the Tete district had returned home. — Sapa.
