

MNR attack health centre

MNR bandits attacked the Marrere health centre on the outskirts of Nampula city on Saturday, seizing large quantities of health materials, equipment and medicine.

The Maputo daily Noticias reported yesterday that the group of 50 men were armed with AK rifles, spears and machetes.

They entered the health centre at 4.30 am and stole syringes, tweezers, injections and medicines. They also took a number of serums which they later destroyed and left lying on the road close to the health centre.

The attackers also destroyed all of the centre's files. While in Marrere, the group also looted a number of houses and burnt five to the ground.
