

# 'SA man killed' in Mozambique

JOHANNESBURG — A South African man is believed to have been killed on Wednesday when a convoy of lorries and private cars was ambushed in southern Mozambique near the South African border post.

A police sergeant in Komatipoort said a farmer told him a South African citizen had been killed in the ambush. An export-import agency official in Malelane said yesterday it

was unclear who is responsible for ambushing the convoy which did have a Mozambican military escort. He suggested it could have been MNR rebels or "bandits".

He said a driver of one of his agency's lorries had told him there were "20 bodies lying in the road after the ambush" and that 27 people were injured in the attack. One of the wounded died overnight in a local hospital. — Sapa.
