

SA accused of training rebels

MAPUTO, Mozambique. — The Mozambican army has accused South African police of training anti-government rebels, the AIM national news agency reported yesterday.

If true, it would mean South Africa has violated a 1984 treaty between the countries in which it pledged to halt all aid to Renamo rebels.

President Joaquim Chissano has often accused SA of violating the accord, a charge SA denies.

SA police and foreign affairs spokesmen said they could not comment.
